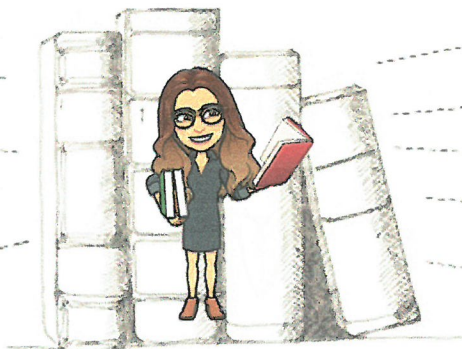

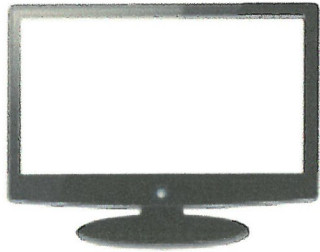

## Late work policy

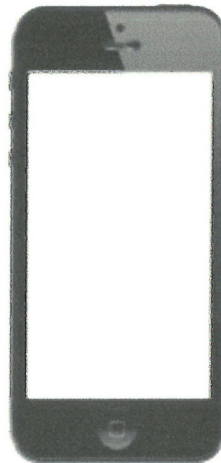
Assignments turned in one day late will receive half credit. Beyond 2 days, work will not be accepted
